The work of All Saints is made possible, under God, through individuals' giving, for which we are most grateful.

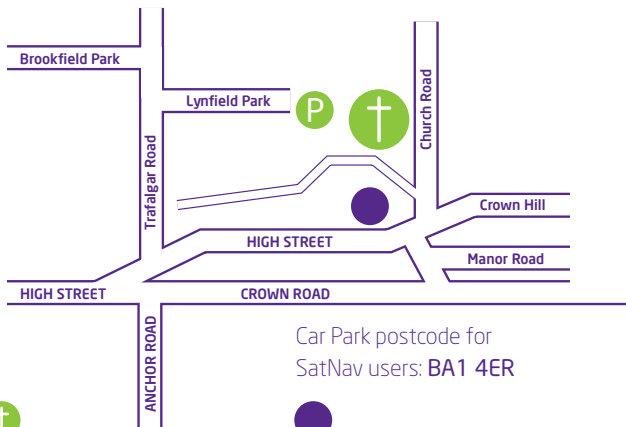
